If requested, your picture will be returned to you when the order is filled. (Help save the American Legion the expense of returning photo by sending a digital copy or original copy)

The banner will be on display prior to Memorial Day through Veterans Day (November 11).

The price of the banner is \$135. A visual inspection will be performed yearly to determine if replacement is necessary. The sponsor is responsible for replacement.

*Qualifications needed with the application of the banner:

> Proof of service in the United States Armed Forces (DD 214, Awards, Government ID)

- > The honoree should be a current member of the community, (or have resided here prior to their passing) or sponsoring family living in the community, a resident at the time of service.
- The picture should be at least 3 x 5 and no larger than 8 x 10.

• The application must be approved by the Hometown Heroes Veterans Banner Committee of American Legion Post 165.
