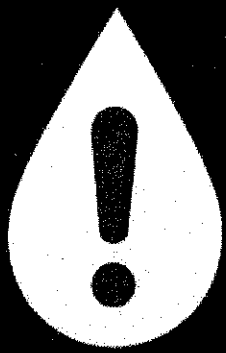


The Village issued the Boil Water Notice as a precaution following the recent heavy rainfall, which caused increased turbidity (cloudiness) in the source water.

At this time, no drinking water standards or regulatory limits have been exceeded. However, out of an abundance of caution, the Village is conducting additional monitoring and water quality testing to ensure the continued safety of the public water supply.

The Boil Water Notice will remain in effect until testing confirms the water is safe. Once the notice is lifted, residents will be notified through the Village website.

WHAT SHOULD I DO?



Bring water to a
ROLLING BOIL
for at least
ONE (1) MINUTE,
then allow it to cool
before using it for:

- ✓ Drinking
- ✓ Making ice
- ✓ Brushing teeth
- ✓ Preparing food or infant formula
- ✓ Washing fruits and vegetables
- ✓ Making coffee, tea, or other beverages

WATER CAN STILL BE USED FOR:



Bathing and showering
(avoid swallowing water)



Washing dishes
(if sanitized properly)



Laundry



General cleaning



WHY IS THIS NOTICE BEING ISSUED?

This precautionary boil water notice has been issued because conditions have occurred that may allow contamination of the drinking water system. As a precaution, customers are advised to boil water until testing confirms the water is safe to drink.

The water system is taking the necessary corrective actions and collecting water samples. The notice will remain in effect until testing confirms the water meets all drinking water standards.
